## **"THINK ABOUT YOUR WORLDVIEW"**

*"And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence" (Colossians 1:18). Most translations render preeminence as "first place". We understand, or we should, what "first place" means. We also understand this "so that in everything he might have the supremacy" NIV.*

*The average Christian does not have a well formulated worldview. They have one for sure but it probably wouldn't qualify as Christian, or said better...a Biblical worldview. In simplest terms, a worldview is governed by one's beliefs.*

*The first piece of a Biblical worldview is anchored in the "supremacy" of Jesus Christ over all things. Christ is at the center of a believer's life. The name of Jesus Christ is exalted above all names. He is the Lord of all; all knees will bow and tongues confess, no exceptions. Earthlings can come under that Lordship of Jesus Christ now or be forced to acknowledge the same at the end of time, when for them it will be too late (Philippians 2:9-11).*

*Since Jesus Christ is Lord over all, that means I am not! As Lord, He determines all the standards for faith and practice. The follower of Christ does not live their life by their own dictates. How we think about marriage, children, education, government, money, work, finances, etc. is spelled out by the Lord. Christian people take on the nature and values of the Lord's Kingdom.*

*If this is burdensome to a believer, then that believer has a poor relationship with the Lord, if one at all. A relationship with the Lord that is based on His demands and our performance is not only futile, it's impossible. Relationship with Jesus Christ cannot be earned or deserved. God paid our insurmountable debt in full. Nothing is owed Him. Christianity is miserable if all the while we are trying to pay Him back.*

*For everything comes from God alone. Everything lives by His power, and everything is for his glory. To him be glory evermore" (Romans 11:36) LB. Our connection to Christ as "Lord of all" is made possible by a thankful and loving heart for the unconditional love and grace He has shown to us. Love makes His Lordship and our corresponding worldview, a delight. The apostle says it this way, "The love of Christ compels us" (2 Corinthians 5:14).*

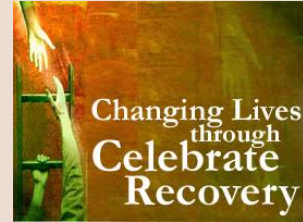
