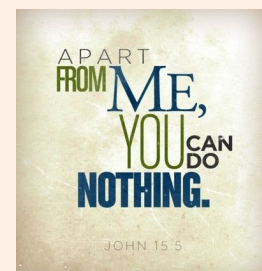
"Things Go Better With Prayer!"

It was in the 1960's that the slogan "Things go better with Coke" was birthed...really? Truth is, things really don't go better with Coke, but things do go better with prayer. That truth took human beings a long time to learn; we are still learning!

The first mention of people calling on the name of the Lord was after Enosh, the son of Seth, the son of Adam, was born (Genesis 4:26). Why it took until Adam's grandson was born, for men to begin "calling on the name of the Lord," remains a mystery. We can be happy that men began calling on the name of the Lord, but we can also be sad it took two complete generations (Adam's and Seth's) before "calling on the Lord" commenced.
